The Severn Barrage: Europe's Largest Proposed Marine Renewable Energy Project



The presentation will review the current main Severn Barrage proposals, as originally promoted by the Severn Tidal Power Group, together with giving a brief overview of alternative options such as the Shoots Barrage and Offshore Tidal Impoundments. In particular, emphasis will focus on assessing the potential hydro-environmental impact of a barrage, including the implications for geomorphological and flood risk changes. Finally, an outline will be given of recent research undertaken by the Hydro-environmental Research Centre, at Cardiff University.
